Executive summary

The ASPP (Assistant Prevention and Protection Service Officer) training course is aimed at preparing professionals to support the Prevention and Protection Service Manager (RSPP) in managing workplace risk assessment and safety procedures. Participants will gain in-depth knowledge of relevant legislation, including Legislative Decree 81/2008 and the State-Regions Agreement of 07/07/2016, and learn tools for hazard identification, risk evaluation, and safety measure management. The curriculum covers essential topics such as accident prevention, emergency procedures, worker training and communication. It also includes internal control and monitoring techniques, incident and near miss analysis, and management of personal protective equipment. The course employs a teaching approach combining theoretical lessons, practical exercises, and case studies aimed at developing effective operational skills for the ASPP role. Upon completion, participants will be able to actively contribute to the company's prevention system, ensuring regulatory compliance and workplace safety.
