Executive summary

The "Workers Safety Training – High Risk" course is designed to deliver comprehensive safety education for workers engaged in high-risk activities. Spanning a total of 16 hours—4 hours of general training and 12 hours of specific training—the course addresses key hazards encountered in high-risk operations such as mechanical handling, chemical exposure, working at height, and electrical risks. The curriculum develops both theoretical knowledge and practical skills essential to identify, prevent, and manage hazardous situations, aligned with the requirements of Legislative Decree 81/2008 and the State-Regions Agreements. This training targets employees working in industrial, construction, logistics, or agricultural sectors where workplace dangers significantly impact individual and collective safety. Through practical case studies and interactive discussions, participants gain effective tools to operate safely and reduce workplace accidents. The course also includes a minimum 6-hour refresher every five years to keep competencies and prevention measures current.

Certification process

- Registration or login to the Academy platform.
- Completion of the final course examination only. Any training or preparation may be completed externally or through other channels.
- The test questions refer to the objectives, skills and topics described in this technical sheet.
- Assessment of the result, possible validation and certificate issuance according to the rules applicable to the course.
