## Executive summary

The course "Supervisor (Preposto) Training – pursuant to Legislative Decree 81/08" is designed for individuals who currently hold or aim to assume the role of supervisor within a company, providing specific knowledge on occupational health and safety in accordance with current regulations. The training covers the supervisor's responsibilities in daily safety management, risk identification, work organization, and appropriate conduct during emergencies. It follows the provisions of Legislative Decree 81/2008 and the State-Regions Agreement of April 17, 2025, ensuring up-to-date compliance with legislative changes. Topics include worker training and verification, shift and stress management, safety supervision in temporary sites with multiple contractors, and managing interference among contractors. Through detailed practical cases, the course prepares supervisors to identify and manage imminent dangers, coordinate activities in departments handling chemicals and moving machinery, and effectively handle emergencies. The course has a minimum duration of 12 hours, with a biennial refresher of at least 6 hours needed to maintain competencies. It suits team leaders, supervisors, and intermediate roles requiring in-depth workplace safety management skills.
